Likelihood:

The risk matrix includes five levels of likelihood, which are described below:

Likelihood	Description		
Rare	Very unlikely – the event may occur only in exceptional circumstances		
Unlikely	Improbable – the event is not likely to occur in normal circumstances		
Possible	Potential – the event could occur at some time		
Likely	Probable – the event will probably occur in most circumstances		
Almost certain	Very likely – the event is expected to occur in most circumstances		

Consequence The risk matrix includes five levels of consequence: insignificant, minor, moderate, significant and major. This takes into account the impact, or potential impact, of an event including its scale and duration. A consequence might affect the safety and wellbeing of children at the service, their family or the wider community.
