Educator statements have all the information about the fees for the care the educator has provided.

- 1. Full Fee Charged This is the full fee for the child's day
- 2. **CCS** The CCS that was paid for that day
- 3. **ACCS** The additional top up amount paid (this could be for ACCS CW, Grandparents, Temporary, Financial Hardship or Transition to Work
- 4. ISS Amount paid for ISS
- 5. Fee Charged The gap amount
